Wool shirt, M1937
Cap, Garrison ("Overseas Cap"), OD, wool w/infantry piping
Undershirt, OD
Tags, Identification ("Dog Tags"), notched, with neck chain and extension
Belt, Web, Waist, M1937, OD #3 w/EM open buckle (officers w/gold buckle)

US COMBAT CLOTHING – 101ST AIRBORNE:

Jacket, Field, M1943 w/101st Airborne Patch
Trousers, Field, M1943
Boots, Combat, M1943, 2-Buckle or Jump Boots
Wool shirt, M1937
Cap, Garrison ("Overseas Cap"), OD, Airborne w/infantry piping
Undershirt, OD
Tags, Identification ("Dog Tags"), notched, with neck chain and extension
Belt, Web, Waist, M1937, OD #3 w/EM open buckle (officers w/gold buckle)

WINTER CLOTHING FOR ALL US PERSONNEL:

Cap, Wool Knit, M1941 ("jeep cap")
Sweater, Wool, High Neck (5 button)
Scarf, Neck, Wool (may also be made from a wool blanket)
Gloves, Wool, OD, Leather Palm

FIELD EQUIPMENT FOR ALL US PERSONNEL:

Helmet, Steel, M1 (OD #3 webbing)
Bag, Canvas, Field, M1936 ("Musette Bag"), OD #3 for Airborne
M1928 Haversack, Canvas,), OD #3 for 28th ID
M6 Gasmask Bag for or Bag, General Purpose (GP or Ammo Bag)
Combat Suspenders, Belt, M1936, OD #3
Cover, Canteen, M1910, OD #3
Canteen, M1910 or M1942 (aluminum or stainless steel)
Cup, Canteen, M1910 (aluminum or stainless steel)
Pouch, First Aid, M1942, OD#3
Cover, Entrenching Tool, M1928 or 1943
Tool, Entrenching, M1910 or 1943

MISC FIELD OR BARRACKS GEAR:

Poncho, OD
Wire Cutters, M1936, w/case
Sheet, Cotton, White (2)
Blanket, Wool, OD

Sub-Machinegun, M3 OR M3A1 (Grease-Gun) Pistol
Automatic, Cal .45, M1911 or M1911A1 Pistol (officers)
Browning Automatic Rifle (BAR)

NO "CAPTURED" GERMAN WEAPONS!!!

CREW SERVED:

US MALE GROOMING STANDARDS:
